- one of the most important pictures Jesus ever painted.
- This was the grapevine grown all over Palestine.
- Needed attention.

- Drastically pruned every December and January.
 - Bore two kinds of branches
 - one fruit-bearing.
 - one non-fruit-bearing.
 - The non-fruit-bearing branches are drastically pruned back so that they will drain away none of the strength of the plant.

The wood of the vine has the curious character-istic that it is good for nothing.

Too soft to use for any purpose.

At certain times of the year it became a bonfire.

- -- Jesus says His followers are like that.
 - Some of them are lovely, fruit-bearing branches of Himself.
 - others are useless because they bear no fruit.

- Christians who were all leaves and no fruit.
- christians who became apostates, who heard the message, accepted it, but who fell away.
- Three ways in which we can be useless branches.

- 1) Refuse to listen to Christ at all.
 - Listen, and then render Him lip service, unsupported by any deeds.
- 3. Accept Him as Master, then in the face of difficulty or being lured back into the world we can abandon Him.
 - branch that bears no fruit

must be destroyed if the rest of the vine is to be preserved.

- In order to bear fruit we must abide in Him.
- Jesus withdrew Himself into solitary places to meet God.
- We must do the same thing.
- -- We must keep contact with Him.

It must be constant and deliberate.

Never a day when we do not sense His presence.

- Without this abiding you cannot do anything that will be spiritually pleasing to God.

"Without me ye can do nothing."

You may be surprised, but nowhere in the Bible does

God ask you to live the Christian life.

- -- He has not even promised to help you live the Christian life.
- Only one Person Who can
 live the Christian life
 and that is the resurrected,
 ascended Lord Jesus Christ.
- You abide in Him, and He
 thinks with your brain,
 He looks through your eyes,

He loves with your heart, He works with your hands, He walks with your legs.

We hear a great deal about the fruit of the Spirit.

The fruit of the Spirit is nothing but the attributes of Christ.
