The Charismatic Movement

- -- Paul said, "Now concerning matters pertaining to the Spirit, I would not have you ignorant." (I Corinthians 12:1).
- Impossible to understand the Bible
  - Christian living
  - the structure of the Church
    - Without Holy Spirit.

He is a Person Ell 4:11

CharisMATA Rom 12 Lan 12

- not an agent or influence
  - He is God.
    - not "it."
    - He is not "something," but "Someone."

- "Holy" indicates He is holy within Himself.
- Spirit is used in contrast to that which is flesh and material.

# 1 OMNIPOTENT:

All powerful

"I am full of power by the spirit of the Lord" (Micah 3:8).

# 2. PRESENT EVERYWHERE:

The Holy Spirit is everywhere at the same time.

"Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?" (Psalm 139:7).

- That is one of the reasons Christ went away
  - He could be everywhere at the same time.
    - "It is expedient for you that I go away, for if I go not away, the Holy Spirit will not come unto you." (John 16:7).

That all disciples, no matter where they might gather themselves together, might realize and enjoy His presence.

# 3. ALL KNOWLEDGE

- "But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God" (I Corinthians 2:10)
- -- In the Book of Revelation He is spoken of as having "seven eyes," which is symbolic

- indicating that nothing is hidden from His searching glance and perfect knowledge
  - This ought to lead all of us to walk daily before God.

# 4 ETERNAL:

- "the eternal Spirit."
- He is co-eternal with God the Father and the Son.

- MYTERIE OF The TRINITY

ILL: Apple

ILL: Ice, water, vapor

all the same

but take different forms.

- 5. HOLY:
- He is referred to over 100 times as "the Holy Spirit."
  - "Be ye holy, even as I am holy"

    is God's command

who alone can impart divine holiness.

- The Holy Spirit bears witness to Jesus Christ who is the Truth.
- In fact, we hear a lot about young people taking drugs to go on a spiritual trip.
  - -- Remarked one young man who had been converted to Jesus Christ:
    - -- "To induce spirituality by
      taking drugs is like trying to
      turn on your TV set by kicking it."

6. WHERE HE IS, THERE IS LIBERTY:

- out from The Bondge of Landing

The Holy Spirit liberates.

Flexhold - We shot know all the answer

ILL: A band of rampaging militants - far fan Ago
ripped a vending machine to
pieces and one shouted

- -"This machine is liberated!"
  - They weren't talking about liberty
  - They were talking about vandalism
    - which leads to bondage.

### ILL: As Eric Hoffer says

"The best test of freedom is not in what we are free to do but in what we are free not to do."

Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty." (II\_Corinthians\_3:17)

- I. THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:
- 1) Convicts

"And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment" (John 16:8).

- Uses mother's prayers
  - tragic experience
  - pastor's sermons.

- 2 He gives new life
  - dead in sin
    - man needs new life in Christ.

### ILL: Mark Twain

- was not a happy man
- once lamented, in a moment
  of candor
  - did not miss the boat."

ILL: Clown and psychiatrist.

ILL: Bertrand Russell wrote to a friend

"I could think of nothing but suicide," for over man and all his works night falls, pitiless and dark."

- Man without God is dead
  and life is at best a bore.
- "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God"

  (John 3:3).
- "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost" (<u>Titus 3:5</u>).

# 3. HE indwells:

many of our young people are spiritually dead and surfeited with the issues of our hour in history.

- ILL: <u>Time magazine</u> quotes a 19-year-old girl as saying,
  - -- "I'm tired of anti-pollution;

    all the Course The fun involled

    I'm tired of Givil Rights;

    I'm tired of life. I just wish

    I could start life all over again."

- "And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them" (Ezekiel 36:27).
- "He dwelleth with you, and shall be in you" (John 14:17).

"Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?"

(I Corinthians 3:16).

# 4) HE empowers for service:

- "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me" (Acts 1:8).

## ILL: In Wakefield, England

for the 38th time
and failed.

- Perhaps you have tried nearly that many times for a license spiritually to sit in the driver's seat of your life
  - Will you move over and trust the Holy Spirit to drive and control your life?

57 HE produces the fruit of the Spirit:

"But the fruit of the Spirit is

love, joy, peace, longsuffering,

gentleness, goodness, faith,

meekness, temperance" (Galatians 5:22,23)

- Romans\_7 is a chapter of defeat.
  - Romans 8, the Holy Spirit is mentioned 12 times
    - it is a chapter of victory.
- -- We are told to "walk in the Spirit,"

- 6 HE opens and shuts doors:
  - "For the Holy Spirit shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say" (Luke 12:12).
  - Without Him your life is directionless.

- HE magnifies, glorifies, and exalts the Son:
  - "He shall not speak of himself" (John\_16:13).

# 8. HE fills:

"Be not drunk with wine...but be filled with the Spirit" (Ephesians 5:18).

HOLY SPIRIT:

- 1. You can anger the Spirit
  - As I pick up the Bible I do discover the "wrath" of the Spirit.

- equal
  - they have equal feelings.
- "How often they rebelled...and grieved him in the desert"

  (Psalm\_78:40 RSV)

- The translation from the Septuagint:
  - "They disobeyed, and made angry the Spirit of God."
  - "They rebelled, and grieved his holy Spirit...therefore he turned to be their enemy, and himself fought against them" (Isaiah 63:10, RSV).

The word "grieve" here means

- "to make angry."

be very careful lest you rouse the wrath of the Spirit.

"My spirit shall not always strive with man" (Genesis 6:3).

- 2. HE can be lied against:
  - "Thou hast not lied unto man, but unto God" (Acts 5:4).

- Here we have direct evidence of the deity of the Spirit.
  - Ananias and Sapphira did not utter a lie
    - they acted a lie.
      - They pretended to be what they were not.

- 3. The Holy Spirit can be tempted:
  - "How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord?"

    (Acts 5:9).

- Many times sinners say
  - "Well, if God is God, let Him strike me dead."

ILL: Old eagle at Niagara.

- 4 The Holy Spirit can be resisted:
  - as your fathers did, so do ye"

    (Acts 7:51).

- A solemn thing to resist the Holy Spirit
  - you detect His voice
  - and yet you deliberately refuse.

- It is a dangerous thing to resist the Spirit.
- He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:
  - of how much sorer punishment,
    suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy,
    who hath trodden under foot the Son
    of God, and hath counted the blood

of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?" (Hebrews 10:28-29).

- "Despite" here means "insult."
- It is a terrible thing to knowingly, wilfully, reject the wooing of the Spirit of God.
- 5. You can blaspheme the Holy Spirit:

of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto them" (Matthew 12:31).

- Here is a sin that disturbs many people.
- "Because there is wrath, beware lest he take thee away with his stroke: then a great ransom cannot deliver thee" (Job 36:18).

- "He, that being often reproved hardeneth his neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy" (Proverbs 29:1).
- "Boast not thyself of tomorrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth" (Proverbs 27:1).
  - Here tonight you are voting for one of two persons:
    - Jesus Christ
       or the devil.
