ILL: This is a night for the military here in Boise, Idaho

- Perhaps the most prominent military
 man we've had here in the United
 States was 5-Star General, and then
 President: Dwight D. Eisenhower
- Before his death, he calculated that unless we have a moral and spiritual REBIRTH throughout the world
 - one of these days we're going to wake up in the dust of a thermo-nuclear explosion.

ILL: Catholic in Army

- Number 41
 - 'Are you weary and heavy laden?

ILL: Religion

— "You didn't get it here"

INTRODUCTION:

- -- Nicodemus
 - great religious leader

- came by night
- probably afraid of criticism
 - or had desire for private conversation
 - or more thought before committing himself

ILL: Priest in Chicago from Poland

- Many of you have thought a long time about religion and Christianity.
- Living in a revolutionary and changing world

- Man's <u>moral ability</u> lagging behind his technological ability
- Could mean disaster and catastrophe for the human race
- World war in this decade

ILL: Ann Landers

- on Tuesday this week in the IDAHO
 STATESMAN
- quoted Dr. Jules Masserman
 - -- (Honorary Life President of the World Association For Social Psychiatry)

- of that body of psychiatrists, that:
 - Acknowledged experts in international and military affairs agreed that, unless present trends are reversed, chances are 4 in 5 that a nuclear war will destroy civilization in the next decade."

Greatest need in the world is a transformation of human nature.

ILL: General Omar Bradley

- as he participated in President Reagan's Inauguration
- Asked if he thought man would emerge alive from the twentieth century
- he expressed grave doubts,
 - giants and ethical infants.

 We know more about war than we know about peace, more about killing than we know about living. We have grasped the mystery of the atom, and rejected the Sermon on the Mount."

- natural birth
- conception
- gestation
- birth

ILL: Ten-year-old boy

- writing on "birth"
- "Stork brought him."

- Nicodemus must have been stunned.
- If Christ had said this to:
 - Zacchaeus, a tax collector;
 - woman at the well; 5 Husbank- on howay

 With smith

 With a man not be Husbank

- the thief on the cross;
- the woman taken in adultery;
 - but to a religious leader!

- Nicodemus was a ruler
 - rich
 - religious
 - and yet "searching for reality"

- He fasted two days a week.
- Spent two hours daily in prayer.
- Tithed all his income.

- Was a professor of theology.
- Worked hard at religion.
 - Jesus said:
 - "It isn't enough: ye must be born again."

- I. WHY DID JESUS SAY THIS?
- Because He knew what was in man.
- ILL: Little boy, after being corrected by teacher several times
 - "I guess I was just born wrong."

- What causes lying, cheating, hate, prejudice, social inequality, war?
- Jesus said,
 - -- "But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart: and they defile the man" (Matthew 15:18)

ILL: Raw recruit in the army

- had been to chapel
- and in his whole life he'd never heard a preacher lay down the law
 - the Ten/Commandments
 - all TEN of them
 - like the Chaplain did that morning!

- he was still quaking as he shook hands with the stern-faced Chaplain at the door
 - who looked at him and solemnly asked:
 - ten of the Commandments?"
- The Private blushed, gulped, and replied:
 - "Well, I ve never made no graven images!"

- Three words used in the Bible which we will use as illustrations:

3 INIQUITY

- A turning aside from the straight path.
- Isaiah 53:6 "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way."

ILL: Sheep and goats.

ILL: Here in Idaho is the sheep state
in the United States

- I haven't seen any goats around that I can recollect!
- In New Zealand they cross sheep and goats and call them GEEPS

- Some of you hardly know whether you're a sheep or a goat.
- One thing you're not, spiritually you're not a GEEP.

Romans_5:12 "Wherefore as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned."

- Thus a radical change is needed by every man
- To find complete fulfilment in this life
- 2. To be acceptable with God.

II. WHAT IS THE NEW BIRTH?

- Nicodemus raised this question:
 - "How can a man be born when he is old?"
- He wanted to understand.

ILL: Black cow

- green grass
- white milk
- and yellow butter

ILL: Understanding color television

ILL: My surgery at Mayo Clinic

ILL: How to go about proving a mother's love in a laboratory

- Nicodemus could see only the physical and the materialistic
 - and Jesus was speaking of the spiritual

- When Jesus said:
 - "You Must Be Born Again"
- He did NOT mean:

- 1) Inheritance:
 - John 1:12 "Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, But of God."

ILL: Born in a garage.

- 2) By Works:
 - Titus 3:5 "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy, He saved us, by the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Ghost."

- 3, Reformation:
 - Isaiah 64:6 "All our righteousnesses are as filthy rags" in the sight of God.

ILL: Pig and the sheep.

4 Imitation:

ILL: "My Fair Lady"

- "I could have danced all night"
- "On the street where she lives"

TO BE BORN AGAIN MEANS:

will I put within you."

- "being alive from the dead."
- In II Corinthians, He calls it
 - "being a new creature"
 - "old things are passed away, behold, all things are become new."
- In Peter, it says: "Being partakers of the divine nature."

- John calls it "passing from death unto life."
- The NEW BIRTH brings about a change in whole philosophy and manner of living.

III. HOW IS IT ACCOMPLISHED?

- A mystery.
- "The wind bloweth where it listeth."

ILL: Naaman at the River Jordan

-- looked ridiculous.

ILL: Burt Frizen and I were students at Wheaton College together

- when World War II broke out
- Burt was inducted into the American Army
- and ended up in a wintry France in the Battle of the Bulge
- It was 1944, and Burt was lying dying in the snow, unconscious

- A Nazi soldier spotted him and came up to him with a drawn bayonet to finish him off.
- Just then, Burt regained consciousness enough to sing softly:
 - Like sweetest music to my ear

 For when my heart is troubled,

 Filled with fear

 Jesus whispers peace."
- The German soldier, holding his bayonet aloft, stood transfixed
 - and awestruck exclaimed in the

 German that Burt could understand:

 "Sing it; sing it again!"

- So, softly, amidst the gory blood,
- bullets and bombs punctuating the silence
 - Burt sang on:
 - "Oh that the world might hear Him speak:

The words of comfort that men seek:

To all the lowly and unto the meek:

Jesus whispers peace"

- At that point, Burt lapsed into unconsciousness.

 - where the Allied Medics picked him up.
