- One of supreme human problems of modern society is loneliness.
- Modern city a lonely place
- Here in America, 70% more people living alone in one person dwellings than 10 years ago

ILL: New York psychiatrist said

· "New York City is the loneliest place in the world for millions."

An American university study

- -- reported that university students are the loneliest people in the United States
 - -- followed by divorced people.

- ILL: One of the principle causes of both alcoholism and drug use
- alcohol and drugs are efforts to escape loneliness
 - medrugs take you on a trip
 - and being drunk makes you feel you've got someone with you!
- on the other hand
 - you really always have Jesus the Lord with you.

- You cannot drink your way out of loneliness
- Most young people turn to drugs for kicks
 - then get hooked
 - but thousands turn because of loneliness

- "our neglected children"
- properly clothed and fed, but "something" is missing in the lives of countless children."

- It's a neglect of the spirit
 - which leaves them lonely"
 - and prone to drugs and alcohol
 - and all too often it <u>leads</u> to suicide. _ -

- One of the key words in the Bible is

II. LONELINESS OF SOCIETY

- ILL: <u>Homeless people on streets</u> of big city
 - I talked to man on 5th Avenue just before Christmas (after giving him \$1 in his outstretched hand)
 - was, and he said "I am all alone."

- Jesus Christ once looked at a helpless, paralyzed man who said
 - "Sir, I have no man when the water is troubled to put me into the pool" (John 5:7)
- For 38 long, weary years
 - this bundle of lonelines and human pain had been buffeted by the surging tides of people
- 🕶 <u>Jesus</u> singled him out
- He became his friend that day, and healed him.
- He can become your Friend tonight.

ILL: President Eisenhower 34 this House About

- ✓ baptized
- chose: "What a Friend we have in Jesus."

"That Christ may settle down and be at home in your heart" (Ephesians 3:17)

ILL: Dingy apartment dweller who never receives a letter nor a handclasp of a friend.

ILL: The Bronx

- ILL: Wealthy society leader whose money has brought everything but happiness men and women going to party after party "What a bore."

- Christ can be your friend.

ILL: Loneliness is found even in the intimacy of marriage.

- Loneliness is an inner dimension
 - a thirst of the spirit

-- the <u>roots of loneliness</u> are within each of us

- ILL: A poll recently revealed that fear and loneliness take over a child's life when a parent suddenly vanishes from the scene
 - whether it's a mother or father.

- 🚄 a romance breaks up
- 🚣 a job is lost

- a grown child leaves home
- = a death

III. THE LONELINESS OF SUFFERING

- When you are suffering
 - me the world ends at the foot of your bed.

"For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us" (Romans 8:18).

Revelation 21:4

"God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away."

IV. LONELINESS OF SORROW

ILL: The older I get

or should attend, as friends die.

🥟 Jesus wept at funeral of friend.

He said, "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die" (John 11:25.26).

V. THE LONELINESS OF SIN

ILL: Professor of psychology says

- 🥕 two basic causes:
 - 1. Feeling that we don't belong
 - 2) No one understands

- ILL: There was an article in the press
 (by Ellie Tesher)
 - on the punk rock kids
 - alienated young
 - who are "going nowhere, looking forward to nothing."
- So they dress, act, and sing (as a representative of their number said):
 - "We all wanted to look like warmed over death.

 That's how we all feel when we aren't high on drugs or booze."

- The deeper and more basic root of loneliness
 - is a sense of isolation from God.

ILL: Loneliness began in the Garden of Eden

- man and woman living together in perfect harmony with each other and with God.
 - Something devastating happensel
 a "declaration of independence"
 - God comes to the Garden calling
 - "Adam, where are you?"
 - and man tries to hide from God.

- Roots of loneliness were planted in the human soul
 - and have been inherited by every inhabitant since

- Loneliness has never been a respecter of persons
- world's greatest artists
 - writers, and composers
- kings, queens, carpenters, and plumbers

ILL: John 13

- 🕶 the Last Supper
- prophesies betrayal of Judas
 - he went out, and it was night.

- Perhaps there was a time that you knew the fellowship of God's people and you had peace with God.

 Both- Confination
 - But you "went out" from the presence of God
 - -- and you found that it was night.
 - You have neither "the fellowship of Christians"
 - nor the "fellowship of sinners"

- and certainly you no longer have the fellowship of Christ.
- Perhaps there is no loneliness quite so bitter as the loneliness of a backslidden Christian. Who Haw now Had clit Bounds
- ILL: Straddling fence
 - ILL: When I was a boy

 "on certain issues"

 I didn't know answers.
 - Sin makes us lonely
 - because it separates us from God.

- Never God's intention for man to be lonely.
- Hundreds of surveys prove that our society has not made us a better adjusted or happier society
- Fleeting moments of sensual satisfaction
 - the sense of pleasure
 - that no psychiatrist can cure.
 - The Bible says that
 - "The wicked are like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt" (<u>Isaiah 57:20</u>).

- VI. THE LONELINESS OF THE SAVIOR
- spent much time in the company of the lonely and the outcast

ILL: Woman at the well

- "He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief" (<u>Isaiah 53:3</u>).
- Even though great crowds surrounded Him at times
 - He was alone.

- Even at the end, the Scripture says
 "All the disciples forsook him,
 - "All the disciples forsook him, and fled" (Matthew 26:56).

- The crowds who had recently shouted "Hosanna"
- -- that very week shouted
 - "crucify Him."

- At last we hear Him cry out
 - forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46).

- Christ hanging on the cross is the loneliest person in the world.
- He experienced ultimate loneliness as He died for you and for me.
- Through His death, Christ dealt with the primary cause of human loneliness separation from God.

- Hell, essentially, is separation from God
 - hell is the loneliest place in the universe
- Jesus suffered its agony for you.

VIII. THE LONELINESS OF YOUR DECISION

- Cannot depend upon parents or friends you must make this decision about Christ yourself.
- Our reaction to loneliness is often to deal with the symptoms rather than the cause.

- Pleasure

- We get involved in our work
- we throw ourselves into a social whirl
- we read one of the best-selling books which urges us to take control of our lives

- Any attempt to deal with sin without conversion (new birth)
 - make struggling in quicksand.
- If we search for an antidote to loneliness in drugs, alcohol, sex, encounter groups, psychological experiences
 - deeper in despair
 - without remedy.

- Through Jesus Christ we can have the most fundamental relationship in life restored.
- if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me" (Revelation 3:20)

ILL: Psalmist who was so lonely

✓ also wrote Psalm 43:5

'Oh my soul why be so gloomy and discouraged. Trust in God.

I shall again praise him for his wondrous help. He will make me smile again, for he is my God."

Loneliness is often God's way of letting us know it is time to "reach out."

- Christ experienced the greatest loneliness the world has ever known
 - so that we would never have to be lonely again.
