- one that I recently read
- a man was swallowed -- for three days Parch Maggie-Anglo 8)

-- he went crazy afterward!

- Jesus picked out an incredible story to confirm it.
- Book of Jonah, four short chapters in the middle of the Bible.
- Covers the entire range of human experience:
  - Sul Love Marcy Reputou Revise
- We have heard many stories and jokes about Jonah being swallowed by a whale but the Bible says:
  - "The Lord prepared a great fish
    to swallow up Jonah."

- the sea, prepared for a unique occasion.
- The Book of Jonah is full of the supernatural.
  - a great fish
  - a gourd
  - a worm
  - an east wind
  - the repentance of an entire city
- Remains an object of faith not explanation.
- I believe it because Jesus confirmed it.

#### I. THE WORD OF THE LORD CAME TO JONAH:

- so concerned about what was
  happening to the fish
  we forget what was happening
  to Jonah
- Trying to find the will of God
- he knew it
- God revealed it to him
- more than 2,000 times the Word of the Lord came " If We know the Bible We know the B
- God speaks by nature, conscience, and His Word.

- God's Word to Jonah was clear:
  - "Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before Me" (Jonah 1:2).
- You were born for a purpose
  - not to satisfy your own wants, appetites or lusts
    - God in redeeming the world.
- Jonah found his orders distasteful.
- -- There was <u>no glamor</u> in being a preacher of judgment

## II. JONAH FLED FROM THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD:

- Joppa
  - the Scripture says, "And he found a ship going down to Tarshish."
- The way of disobedience and sin leads downward to guilt, loneliness, separation and hell.
  - Every step leads lower.
- Every time you flee from the presence of God you're in trouble.

- ILL: Adam and Eve out of the Garden of Eden.
- ILL: Samson, led to blindness, imprisonment and the mill.
- ILL: David led to terrible guilt experience, death, and judgment on his family.
- Many of you are trying to flee from the Lord.
- / We flee by travel.
  - There is a restlessness today.
  - Highways and airports are jammed.

- We flee into lust for things
  - people are buying
  - compulsive shoppers just as there are compulsive drinkers.
  - 3. Flee into obsession with sex
    - -- it is both a fad and a passion
- We flee into mysticism and occultism
  - ILL: Saul went to the witch of Endor instead of God.
  - Sa We escape into pleasure
    - "She that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth" (1\_Iimothy\_5:6).

- But the Bible says
  - so great a salvation?" (Hebrews 2:3).
- What direction are you taking?
- ILL: Man walking through Western North Carolina.
  - Reached signpost
  - one direction pointed to a smooth

    level road

    When he was going
    - but the road pointing to Asheville was rough and steep.

      - he never got to Asheville.

- Many of you are trying to change the markers on the roads of life.
- You want the easy, level, pleasant road
  - but it does not lead to God.

  Tarshish was a great resort
  - and Jonah thought he would enjoy himself there more than in Nineveh.

#### III. JONAH PAID THE FARE THEREOF:

- The wages of sin is death."
- "The way of the transgressor is hard."

- A series of tragedies came to the ship and its crew.
- FGod sent a great wind.
- Sailors afraid.
  - They began to pray to their gods and lighten the ship.

- They wanted to save Jonah
  - they rowed hard
  - than many Christians do.

- Your sin and disobedience not only affect your life, but the lives of others.
- ILL: "If I want to take heroin, that's my business."
  - What about parents?
  - People you steal from?
  - Children unborn?

- ILL: A great medical scientist said sometime ago:
  - "My intensive research is convincing me that marijuana will produce extensive brain damage when used over a period of time.
  - He predicts that within 10 years the majority of hospitals in America are likely to be filled with marijuana users suffering from damaged brains.
- ILL: Some authorities say that as little as one experience with marijuana can leave psychotic disorders.

ILL: Talking to a man in a position to know

he said that cancer develops
8 times faster in a marijuana
smoker than it does a smoker
of cigarettes.

ILL: Jane Fonda

-- "People think I am way out.

They are wrong. I used to be pro-marijuana, but I am against it now. It pacifies people, keeps them out of the action."

ILL: "If I want sex, it's my own business."

- What about the girl you get pregnant?
- The child she bears?
- The guilt in your heart?

- Jonah said, "I'll go where I want to go, and do what I want to do."
- That was his right
  - just as long as he was willing to pay the consequences.

#### IV. JONAH WENT TO SLEEP ON THE BOAT:

- Sin is like a sedative.
- Jonah was sleeping the sleep of disobedience.

ILL: Talked to a man sometime ago

had left his wife married his secretary

he said, "I feel perfectly at peace about it."

- This is a false peace
- it is the peace of disobedience
- the peace of being away from God
  - It will soon end.

- First sin is fun
  - then it is boring
    - then/it makes you insensitive.
- There was a time when you were sensitive to the Word of God.
- It pricked your conscience
  - it brought tears to your eyes
  - it made you uncomforable.
- Now you can turn away without any feeling.

- Jonah's sin affected an entire ship
  - "...visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me" (Exodus 20:5).
  - "None of us liveth to himself" (Romans 14:7).

#### ILL: Famous Bishop

- at first his denials were not very extreme
- later, the Virgin Birth
- later, the authority of Scripture
- these wrong steps soon led to others

- his own liberal church was embarrassed
- this led to personal tragedies
- drinking problem
- joined Alcoholics Anonymous
- three marriages
- one son committed suicide
- drifted into the occult
- finally left the church
  - died in the Middle East

- We must learn to say with David:
  - "Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting"

    (Psalm 139:23.24).

### V. AND THE WORD OF THE LORD CAME UNTO JONAH THE SECOND TIME:

- Do you remember when God began to speak to you first?
- "Backward, oh backward,

  Oh time in its flight

  And make me a child again

  Just for tonight."

- Mot many times does God give a man a second chance.
- ILL: Thief on the cross took his one moment.

- God said
  - "Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and preach to it, the preaching that I have already told you."

- Jonah had graduated from "fish university."
- ILL: Could have written a bestseller entitled JAWS

  or, THE INSIDE STORY

Nineveh was three days journey but Jonah made it in one.

# GOD: Took While My to Walk they the great ag

- Greatest revival in history
- Jonah's obedience brought salvation to an entire city

Even the animals repented

ILL: Wish may dogs would repent!

- When you begin to live for Christ
  - only in your own life, but the lives of others.

- ILL: John Wesley's conversion changed the direction of the nation.
- Nineveh
  - -- labelled for destruction was saved.
- -- A man who was marked for judgment was used of the Lord.
- A man's obedience caused God to "repent of the evil"
- God's mind is made up about you.
- He says, "He that being often reproved hardeneth his heart, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy" (Proverbs 29:1).

- But if you change your mind and repent, God will change His mind about you.
- That is grace and mercy and love.
- God is giving you another chance tonight.

ILL: Corrie ten Boom

- promised God at Ravensbruck (and to Betsie, her sister)
  - that she would go everywhere telling the love of God if she was ever released

- Released because of a clerical error
- she was startled when God told her to go to Germany to tell the love of God.

- Psychiatrists now agree that every illness has two diagnoses:
  - the scientific, which deals with the physical
  - and the spiritual, which deals with the meaning of the disease
  - The main cause of neurotic disease is spiritual.
