- change in moral standards
- Do you really want a standard?

What does the Bible say?

- Do you have courage enough to listen to the Bible?
- Sex is not sin
- -- Many ancient and modern writers hold that the body is evil.

ILL: George Bernard Shaw wrote,
"In the life of the world
to come you escape this
tyranny of the flesh."

- Plato taught that the body was evil.
- The Bible teaches that the body is "the temple of the Holy Spirit."
- A distinction in the New Testament between the flesh and the body.
- partly responsible for the supression of sex in the last generation.

- Scripture says Adam "knew"
 his wife and they became one
 flesh:
 - For the propagation of the race,
 - 2 Climax of married love.
 - 3. To express unity.

ILL: A type of Christ and the Church.

- garden it affected his sexual life, lust entered. God's great gift had been perverted.
- Difference between love and lust.

Why God says, "Thou shalt not commit immorality."

- 1. To protect the marriage.
- 2. To protect your body
 - ♥ VD epidemic in America
 - Illegitimacy doubled in the last two or three years.
- 3. To protect you psychologically
 - guilt feeling
 - ILL: Radcliffe student,
 "I always feel guilty."
 - emotional disturbances, insecurity, a feeling of being unloved.
- 4. To protect society
 - the moral problem can threaten the security of the nation.

How can a young person have victory over Eros?

The Bible says, "flee fornication."

- The mark of the Christian is self-control and self-discipline
- No way to overcome this tremendous temptation except in Christ.

Paul wrote to Timothy and said, "Keep thyself pure" (I Tim.5:22)

III. PHILIA

- Refers to strong affection

- From it we get our words:
 - Philanthropy (meaning a love for men)
 - Philharmonic (a love for music)
 - philadelphia (city of brotherly love)
- ILL: This was the word which Peter used when Christ asked him if he loved with the highest of loves. Peter, conscious of his recent denial, replied, "Yea, Lord, Thou knowest that I love thee." (John 21:15-17). It is the highest love of which man, by himself, is capable.

- Friendship arises out of companionship.
- ILL: Psychiatrist David Klein said sharp rise in violence and crime the world over can be traced directly to loneliness

 a cosmic loneliness which can be traced to no real

and unshakeable friendships.

- ILL: Jesus said, "I have called you friend."
- ILL: I have many friends but really only a few genuine friends.

ILL: God called Abraham "a friend of God."

In Christ friendship can deepen.

IV. AGAPE LOVE

This is God's love

Four features of Agape love:

- 1. It is spontaneous
 - goes out to its object and captures it
 - not prompted by anything in man

ILL: Not like the love of man for woman. A man expects a response, and loves to be loved.

- God's love goes out to the enemy.
- 2. It is indifferent to value
 - not because of man's sin, but in spite of his sin.
 - it is only when you realize that there is no worthiness in you at all, can you understand what agape is.
- 3. It is creative
 - it imparts value through love

- what gives you value is the fact that God loves you
- "We have this treasure in earthen vessels."
- 4. It is the <u>initiator of</u> fellowship with God
 - You have no way to come to God
 - But God comes to man in agape, to establish fellowship

"Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners." (Luke 7:34)

MAN'S ABILITY TO LOVE HIS NEIGHBOR

- We hear commandment "love thy neighbor as thyself"
 We are unable to respond
- Hebrews made literal interpretation of neighbor, limiting it to the literal person next door
- Jesus gave the parable of the Good Samaritan
- The neighbor was not the fellow next door but anyone needing help. "A new commandment give I unto you that you love one another." (John 13:34)

Mexico - Pakinta - W. Africa

- He was calling for something the natural man cannot do
- The Christian becomes a channel through which agape of God can flow
- God's love

ILL: In South Pacific:

"A bell is not a bell until you ring it, a song is not a song until you sing it, love is not love until you give it away."

Agape love will drive us to the ends of the world. It is the only love in the world that will transform society.

Everything else is doomed to failure.
