HOW TO PREPARE

ILL: In Ottawa the other day

- as the guest of Prime Minister
 - They showed me an old bell in front of the Parliament building
 - The inscription on the bell read this way:

This bell which belonged to the tower clock of the old Parliament Buildings was taken from the ruins of the Buildings after their destruction by fire on February 3rd 1916. On that memorable night the bell continued to strike the hours until midnight although the tower itself was ablaze from 9 o'clock in the evening. After sounding the last stroke of twelve it crashed through the flames to the base of the tower."
